Newcastle City Council enhances maintenance productivity with new screed vehicle

Newcastle upon Tyne is a university city on the River Tyne in northeast England and the eighth most populous urban area in the United Kingdom. Joined to Gateshead by the iconic Millennium Bridge with its unique tilting aperture, the city is now a centre of business, arts and sciences.





The Challenge

In order to enhance the efficiency of Highway maintenance operations throughout the region, including the A69 across to Carlisle, Newcastle City Council opted to replace an ageing legacy vehicle that was becoming increasing unreliable. The council required the new vehicle to be specified with features that both increased productivity and enabled compliance with all relevant health and safety guidelines.

The Solution

Newcastle City Council specified larger capacity pre-heaters, capable of delivering extended productivity between refilling and enabling jobs to be carried out in less time. The on-board gas storage facility features a single point safe-fill system to provide the highest levels of safety when refuelling. To comply with health and safety guidelines for working at height, Somerford fitted safety railings around the vehicle, plus an integrated pedestrian side step well to improve rear access. The vehicle was also built with fully electronic, rear-mounted LED traffic control lights and platform lighting to ensure the safety of operatives around the clock.

The new screed applicator is equipped with a canopy that extends around the entire vehicle, making it easier for operatives to work in all weather conditions. Other specifications include extended storage facilities for materials and traffic management equipment, and a larger pedestrian hand marking pram to allow for more to be done between refilling.
