CASE STUDY SOLOMARK BUILD FOR HI-WAY



Somerford Equipment enhance Hi-Way Services fleet with the delivery of new SoloMark. Hi-Way Services are a road marking contractor with over 25 years of experience working with a variety of clients, from major organisations to local schools and businesses.





The Challenge

Somerford Equipment were tasked with providing Hi-Way Services a SoloMark unit, the first of which to be done on a Volvo FL chassis. The key requirements were to provide a more economical machine with less impact on the environment. Hi-Way Services had several bespoke additions to add to the built which Somerford's team had no issues modifying. The aim of the new truck was to provide Hi-Way Services with a tailormade road marking truck to serve their fleet for the next decade plus.

The Solution

The new SoloMark has resulted in Hi-Way Services having the ability to carry out works with one truck rather than two on some projects, resulting in a number of benefits. Contracts Manager at Hi-Way Services, Danny O'Reilly explains "The all in one SoloMark will provide us with savings in comparison to a Multimark and Feeder truck due to not requiring a second truck (the feeder), the saving will be on maintenance, fuel and carbon emissions. We estimate a fuel saving of £96'000 per annum and a reduction on Co2 of 68'120kg per annum."

Somerford Equipment modified this SoloMark to cater for Hi-Way Services bespoke design requirements. This included the addition of four manifolds to ensure the truck can always run with both two rib heads and two extrusion heads. A benefit of this means that Hi-Way Services operatives can continue running without the need to change application head when switching from rib to extrusion.

During the build Somerford Equipment ensured Hi-Way Services received regular updates on the progress of the build. While taking regular suggestions on design elements from Hi-Way Services, Somerford Equipment provided regular progress pictures of the build and kept consistent communication with the client throughout the entire build process.
